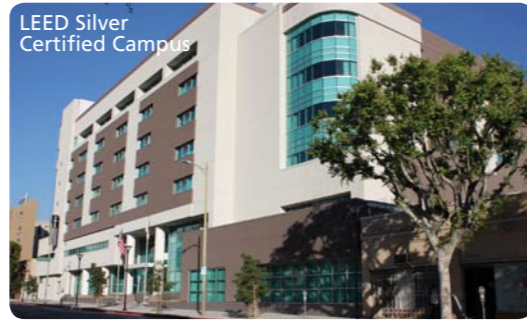




Los Angeles Job Corps Center is located in the heart of LA's booming downtown redevelopment. **Residential and nonresidential students** attend the new, urban campus.

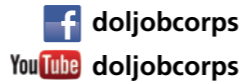
